

RESIDENTIAL HORSERIDING PACKAGE

A dream comes true of having your own horse for a week. You will be based at an equestrian center situated on a lovely remote site surrounded by woods and bogland with endless riding tracks. You will be relaxing in our tastefully restored 300-year-old farmhouse with ensuite rooms. As a more experienced rider you can take your horse out for a different ride every day (with guide if required), and as a novice rider you can take part in the daily horsemanship lessons, as well as the basic riding tuition.

Duration:	8 days (7 nights)
Tour Dates 2008:	Saturday-to-Saturday (Mid April – September 2007)
Level:	Easy to moderate.
Group size:	Minimum of 8, maximum of 16. Individual bookings are welcome.
Equipment:	All tack for horses is provided and helmets for riders. All other riding equipment, such as rain gear, boots, jodhpurs, gloves etc has to be provided by the participant.
Accommodation:	Restored Farmhouse.
Meals:	7 Full Irish breakfasts, 7 dinners and 6 packed lunches are included.
Transfers:	All transfers required as part of the riding programme. Transfer to and from Shannon Airport to the riding centre on day of arrival and departure can be arranged at a cost of €30 per person each way.
Miscellaneous:	The price quoted includes horse and guide for the weeks programme with 15 hours of riding or lessons.
Meeting Point:	If transfer from Shannon Airport is required it has to be pre-booked and you will be met at the meeting point in the arrival's hall of Shannon Airport and brought to the Riding Centre.

Price for residential package €840 per person sharing

All prices are in EURO, and based on per person sharing. Per person sharing means two people in one room.

Single Supplement of €130.00 will be applied to those booking a single room, or those booking a place as an individual where no suitable person is available to share a room and a single room is allocated.

Transfers to and from the Riding Centre have to be booked in advance.
