EACH call out for assistance in the event of a minor problem (e.g. flat tyre) will incur a charge of €70.00. This charge will also apply for unscheduled transfers. Breakdown cover is included in your package only in the event of a serious bike fault such as broken spokes. We will endeavour to get to you as soon as possible, but you may have to wait some time for this service.

In consideration of, and in part payment for, the right to participate in the trip and activities, services and food arranged for me by Killary Tours and its agents and associates in connection with the trip, I have and do hereby fully assume all risk of injuries, illness or death and hereby release and discharge Killary Tours and its associates and agents from all actions, claims or demands for damages resulting from my participation in the trip. GENERAL INFORMATION

BOOKING

Before booking an individual holiday please check with us for availability. A 30% deposit per person will secure your booking, and can be made with either VISA or MasterCard's. This is a non-refundable payment. The balance of payments is due 30 days before the tour starts. After we receive your deposit we will send you a written confirmation, and your pre-departure package.

CANCELLATIONS

Cancellations must be made in writing. Deposit payments of 30% per person are required to confirm a booking, this payment is non refundable. The balance of your tour will be deducted one month before the start date of your tour. No refunds are given for Cancellations after balance has been settled. No refunds are given for services not used by a trip participant. We strongly recommend that you purchase airfare and tour package insurance with your flight supplier at the time you make the deposit.

TRAVEL + Airport Transfers

We include airport transfers in our prices where stated only, please note that these are subject to the Killary Tours time-table; normally we meet guests between 12.00 - 16.00 on day one and transfer back on the last day to be at the airport at approx 12.00. Please contact us in advance so we can help plan your arrival and departure arrangements. We can and do arrange taxis from all airports to any of our tour destinations. Furthermore timetables and rates for National Rail and Bus services can be supplied. We do not organise travel to Ireland from overseas destinations.

HEALTH and FITNESS

Most tours are active holidays, and require at least moderate fitness levels according to description. Tours may involve 4 - 6 hours walking, or 3 - 5 hours cycling a day. Checking the suitability of each tour can help you to avoid disappointment. Those unaccustomed to activity are advised to take gentle exercise before the tour to fully enjoy the experience. Please advise us of any special medical, physical, or health requirements you may have, or conditions such as diabetes, epilepsy, asthma, disabilities, severe allergies, etc. and any medication you may be on.

CLIMATE and CLOTHING

Ireland's climate is mild, frequently damp, highly changeable, with temperatures ranging from 12° to 28° C. We advise that both light and warm clothing is carried and **rainwear is essential**. Especially for the walking tours, good footwear, i.e. waterproof boots with ankle support are essential. A more detailed list of suggested clothing is enclosed with the tours description.

PERSONAL EFFECTS

As the tours are mainly outdoor, we advise clients to bring items such as sun cream, insect repellent, small first aid kit, aspirin, travel sickness tablets if required. On guided tours the tour leader is carrying a complete first aid kit.

FOOD

Most special diets can be catered for, provided we are notified in advance. Please indicate on Booking Form under special dietary needs

CHILDREN

A lower age limit applies to some tours, please check with us in advance of booking.

INSURANCE

We provide public liability for guests on our tours, however, we require you to purchase full health insurance, including coverage for repatriation. Please provide us with an indication that you have purchased this insurance at the time full payment is made. You can purchase this insurance from your travel agent.

RESPONSIBILITY

Killary Tours act as agents for the traveller and can accept no responsibility for the service of any hotel, restaurant or carrier used in connection with these tours, nor any liability for claims, damages, expenses or other financial loss to persons or property. In the event that it becomes necessary or advisable Killary Tours reserves the right to alter a tour should weather, client's preference, or other circumstances intervene. The right is reserved to cancel a tour and to decline to accept any person as a member of a tour at any time.

DUE DILIGENCE

The tours in our brochure have been designed to provide participants with an exposure of the true nature of the environment visited and therefore involve an element of personal risk and exposure to potential hazards above those associated with normal 'package holidays'. Bookings are accepted on the understanding that such risks are appreciated by the client.

All prices quoted are per person sharing. Whilst single accommodation may be available, this is generally not possible on our off site tours, except by special arrangement, and is always subject to availability.
